It began in 1973 when a small group of concerned citizens took up the cause alongside agency's foundress, Sister Lucille Stewart. Working together, they built upon her work in providing meals to impoverished women living in Lancaster. As the number of elderly persons needing assistance grew, this dedicated group of civic minded people pulled together the necessary resources to establish a formalized program. Fairfield Community Meals registered with the State as a 501c3, non-profit organization serving all of Fairfield County.

Over the next five decades, the agency built upon this foundational work to ensure the needs of older adults living in Fairfield County were met. Our name has changed over the years, but the mission has remained the same as we work to improve the quality of life and enable independent living for older adults. In addition to celebrating our 50th anniversary during 2023, the agency also passed the fourth county-wide senior services levy. With this support, the agency continues to flourish and reach more individuals with more services year after year. We have not done this work alone. The success of the agency has come from the support of our community.

We all benefit when people of all ages come together to support each other. I am so very grateful for our amazing staff, volunteers, donors, Board members, the taxpayers, and advocates who support the work that we do to ensure health, connection, and independence for thousands of Fairfield County older adults.
